The 2026 March for Life will take place on Friday, January 23rd in Washington, DC. To encourage more of our people to attend we have reserved a block of rooms at a discounted rate at the *Yours Truly Hotel* in

Washington, DC. More details and a schedule for the weekend are posted on the bulletin board of the church.

Rooms are \$149 a night plus tax. Each individual guest must make his or her own reservation by calling 877-269-5199 and telling them they are with the MYA March for Life.

Please note: The booking link price you see online will show the \$26 destination fee included in the rate. Please rest assured that the charge will not show on your final bill. Rooms need to be booked by December 23, 2025. The blocked room rates could potentially be available past this date if they are able to provide some (this will be determined case by case). Each person booking a room is responsible for their own room fees and is responsible for cancelling if necessary, within the hotel's allowable time period to avoid charges.

Virginia Pro-Life Day

Thousands of pro-life advocates are expected to gather in Richmond Jan. 15 for the fifth annual [Virginia Pro-Life Day](#), as the General Assembly begins its 2026 session and abortion advocates push for a constitutional [amendment](#) that would make abortion a protected "right" in Virginia. The pro-life rally, held at the Virginia State Capitol, is organized by the Catholic Diocese of Arlington and the Catholic Diocese of Richmond, in partnership with other faith-based and pro-life organizations. In a statement provided to CatholicVote, organizers said it has always been the largest citizen advocacy event held during the General Assembly session. Virginia Pro-Life Day will include prayer, speeches, and advocacy meetings with lawmakers. Organizers expect to see participation from people across the Commonwealth, including students, families, clergy, and parish-based group.
