All proceeds will go towards pro-life ministries.

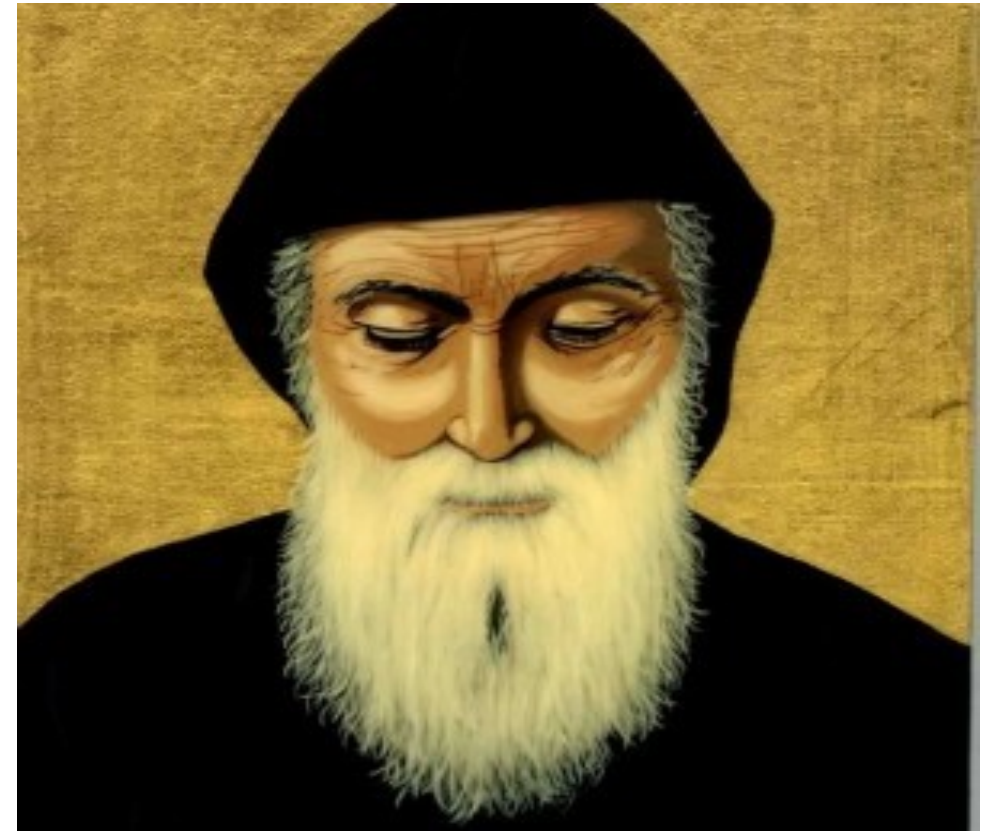
Catholic Homeschool Conference
